What makes this location especially impactful is its integrated model. Alongside weekly gatherings, it hosts programmes for children and youth, small groups, and community-focused initiatives—all within one accessible location. This creates consistent opportunities for individuals and families to be known, supported, and equipped over time.

This represents a highly effective model of ministry—one that maximises reach, fosters long-term transformation, and strengthens the surrounding community by meeting both spiritual and physical needs in a unified, sustainable way.

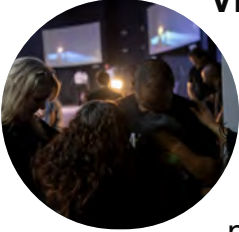

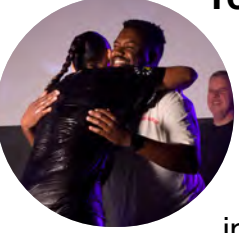

OUR PASTORS



Our Senior Pastors, Andre and Leanne Greeff, are passionate about the local church and believe that God wants to use His Church to change the nation. Leanne is a medical doctor and runs our View Health Clinic. Andre has a heart for raising up and equipping leaders to build God’s Church.

We are Andre and Leanne Greeff and we lead View Church together and love to see people blessed, passionate, and sold out to God’s Kingdom. We have two daughters who love Jesus and are part of our youth team and leadership. Our direction and vision in the church are heavily influenced by our own experiences.

Andre -

I was 18 years old when I met the Lord. I grew up in a traditional church and one day found View Church, where my picture of church was forever changed. I found a life-giving church, and church became something I wanted to pursue and love. At 22 years old, I had a gap in my life and desired to know everything about God. I heard from God to give a year of my life to serving God—serving with no strings attached—and I have been on staff ever since, starting in our youth and now leading the church with my wife, Leanne.

Leanne -

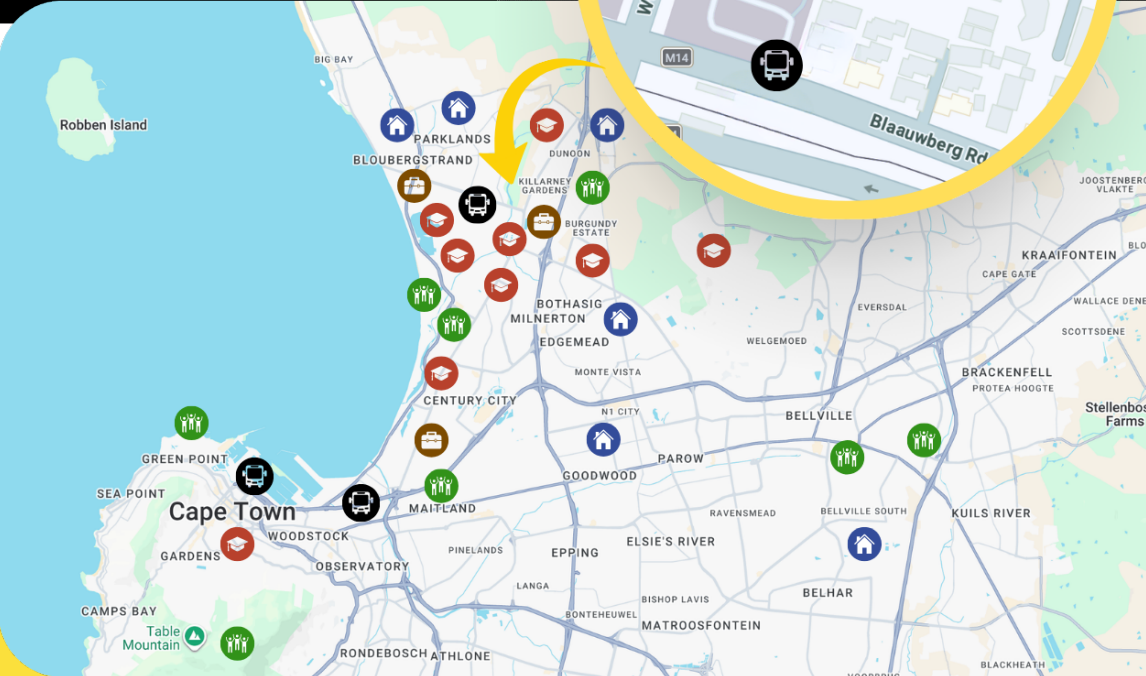
I grew up as a pastor’s kid and was five years old when we joined View Church. I know I was super blessed—my parents loved God and served God their whole lives. They were real people who practised what they preached. They were not perfect people, but they loved God. My mum would make me promise that I would always love Jesus. From an early age, I knew that was my focus. When I trained to become a medical doctor, I had the most intense nine years studying and learning. In all of that time, I always made time for View Group as I knew I needed to be there. Above studying, above all the learning, I needed people who would point me to God and hold me accountable. My purpose was greater than just getting a degree—it was to help others know Jesus.

THE LEGACY

In the early 90s, Graham and Jenny Evans, together with their three children, moved to Table View, Cape Town, with a call from God to serve their community. They joined a local church and became its Senior Leaders, which today is View Church.

Very early in their leadership, they trusted that the empty land around them would be used for God’s purposes, and for over 30 years they have trusted, believed, and watched as the land has stood empty and ready for the purpose of God. Today, after more than 30 years of prayer and trusting God, the land has been formally offered to View Church and forms a significant part of our building plans. One of our Senior Pastors, Leanne Greeff, is the daughter of Graham and Jenny. She remembers the prayer walks, the excitement, and declarations surrounding the land when she was a young girl.

INVESTING IN ONE OF CAPE TOWN’S MOST STRATEGIC SUBURBAN GROWTH CORRIDORS.

View Church is embarking on a building expansion project—a strategic initiative to increase capacity, enhance ministry environments, and prepare for the future growth of our church and community.

The View Church Building Expansion is a direct response to the growth and momentum we are experiencing as a church. Each week, more individuals and families are finding community, growing in their faith, and calling this place home—stretching our current spaces beyond their intended capacity.

Building Community Impact

The new site will be a hub designed to be a catalyst for community life—bringing people together in a way that is both intentional and organic. By creating welcoming, flexible spaces that invite connection, it will serve as a place where relationships are formed, strengthened, and sustained. More than just a building, it becomes a consistent presence in the area—cultivating belonging, encouraging participation, and shaping a vibrant, connected community over time.

This project reflects our vision to not only make room for more people, but to create environments where lives can be transformed. Through expanded gathering areas, enhanced children’s spaces, and the addition of the Champions Club for children with special needs, we are building a space where everyone can belong, grow, and thrive.

For us, this is more than a building project—it is an investment in people and in the future of our community. This expansion will allow us to continue reaching more lives, strengthening families, and extending our impact for years to come.



OUR LOCATION

The land opportunity surrounding View Church is located within one of Cape Town's most strategic and active northern growth corridors. Strong public transport infrastructure, continued residential expansion, family migration, school demand, commercial investment, and daily community movement all support the long-term ministry potential of this site.

1. Major Public Transport Hub – MyCiTi



Table View serves as a key interchange point within MyCiTi Bus Rapid Transit System, which links northern suburbs to the Cape Town CBD and major destinations across the metro. According to MyCiTi's official service information, the network spans multiple key corridors across the city, connecting areas from Atlantis in the north through to Hout Bay in the south, and from Sea Point in the west to Khayelitsha in the east. This places Table View within one of the city's most connected suburban corridors.

2. Sustained Residential Growth on the West Coast Corridor



The broader Table View, Parklands, Sandown, and Blaauwberg corridor has been one of Cape Town's strongest residential growth zones for many years. This growth has largely been driven by relative housing affordability and ongoing new residential development.

3. Strong Family Demographic and School Demand



Table View has developed into a well-established family suburb supported by multiple public and private schools. Nearby institutions include Table View Primary School, Table View High School, Blouberg International School, and numerous early learning centres and preschools. The continued expansion of schooling infrastructure reflects sustained family demand in the area.

4. Expanding Business Infrastructure and Employment Activity



The Table View corridor has evolved into a mixed residential and commercial hub, supported by retail centres, professional services, logistics access, and growing business districts. Cape Town tourism and economic publications continue to recognise the area as an increasingly important lifestyle and business node.

5. Daily Hub of Community Activity



Table View functions as a live, active corridor where people regularly live, work, commute, and access recreation and healthcare. Its combination of transport routes, retail centres, schools, beaches, and residential density makes it one of the busiest suburban hubs along Cape Town's West Coast corridor.

THE INITIATIVE

LAND ACQUISITION

Phase one of this new project is to purchase the land behind the church.

On 31 October 2025, View Church was formally offered the opportunity to purchase a portion of the land directly behind our current building. The price of the land is R14 400 000, excluding VAT and transfer costs.

The offer to purchase this land expires after 12 months, which means that we need to have begun the purchase process before the end of October 2026. View Church is acquiring an additional 4,424m² of land, and the City of Cape Town will receive a small portion of our existing land from View Church as part of this purchase.



CAR PARK

The car park is not just where you leave your car but is the first impression you have of our church building. From the moment you drive into our first-class parking, we want you to have the warmest and most welcoming experience. We will have enough parking for everyone to join us, and we intentionally reserve the best spaces for guests, young families, and those with mobility needs. Our new people get the best spots, along with those who have small children or have difficulty walking. Everyone receives a warm View Church welcome as they join us. Our car park is designed to be safe and easy to use.

FUTURE PLANS: NEW CONSTRUCTION

This project brings together a range of thoughtfully designed environments that support both ministry and community life. A welcoming lobby leads into a larger main auditorium, while integrated communal spaces create opportunities for connection beyond services.

Dedicated children’s ministry areas provide engaging spaces for the next generation, alongside the Champions Club—a specialised environment for children with special needs.

Supporting spaces for volunteers and flexible ministry use ensure the location functions effectively throughout the week.

Combined with site improvements such as additional land, expanded parking, and improved circulation, these elements create a cohesive and highly functional location.



CHAMPIONS CLUB

The Champions Club is a dedicated space designed specifically for children with special needs, including those who are medically fragile. This environment ensures that every child has the opportunity to participate, belong, and thrive, reflecting the church’s commitment to inclusivity and care for all families.

LOBBY

Designed as a welcoming, light-filled environment, the lobby serves as the central gathering space of the church. With its open, glass-wrapped design, this area encourages connection, conversation, and community before and after services—creating a first impression that is both inviting and engaging.



CHILDREN’S MINISTRY

The children’s ministry environments are being significantly expanded to create safe, engaging, and age-appropriate spaces for children to learn and grow. These areas are designed to support both increased capacity and a high-quality experience, investing in the next generation in a way that is both intentional and scalable.

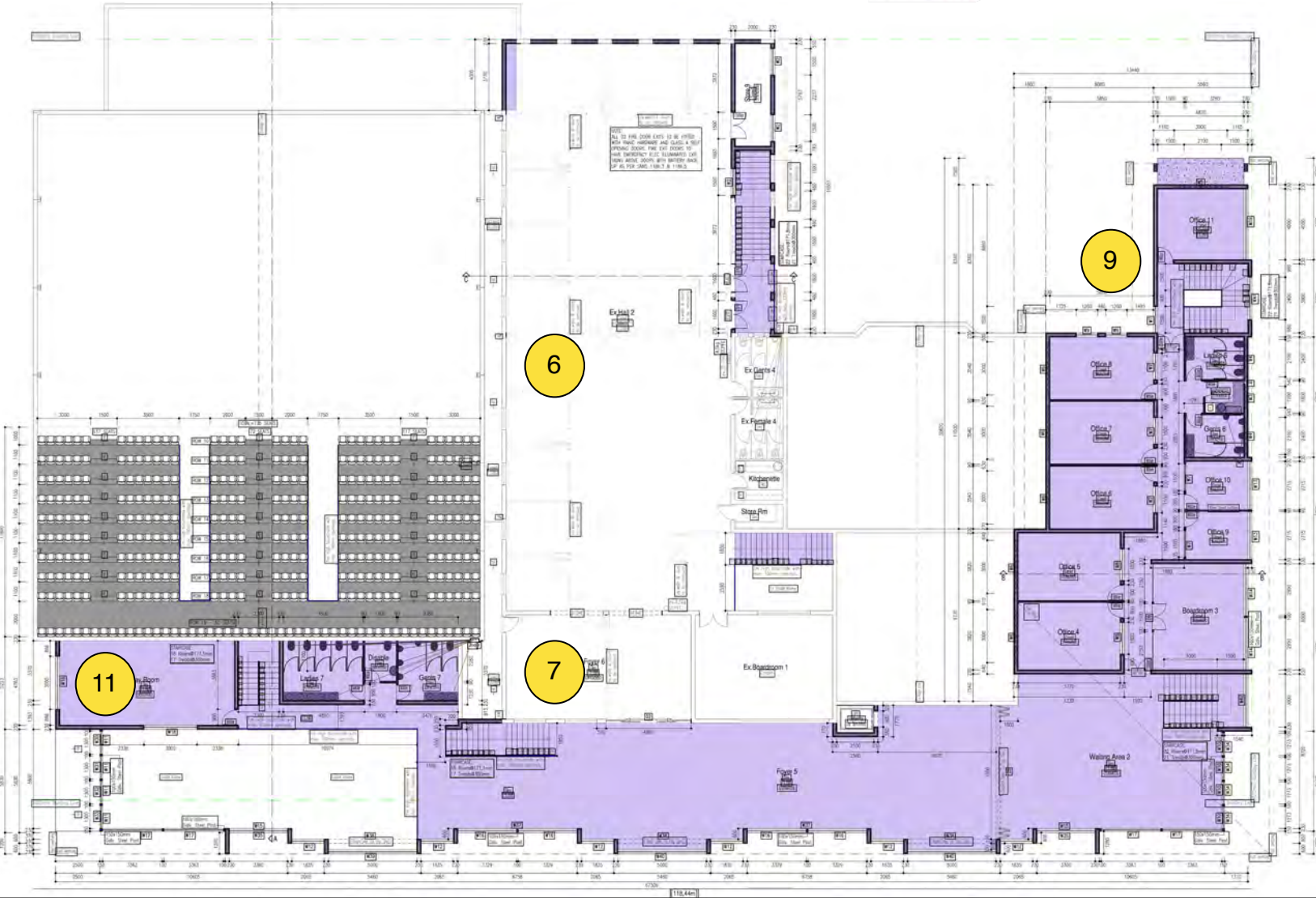


COMMUNAL SPACES
